If you are receiving this email it's because we believe your organisation can be a good match for the **Erasmus + Mobility of Youth Workers** project we are applying for.

The Southern Lights (GR) and Naumanni (IT) organisations are planning an 11 days residential program that combines Permaculture theoretical & practical lessons with a Yoga & Body Movement curriculum. The project is addressed to participants issued by different EU countries who represent organisations that are already working in the field of ecology and sustainability or who are interested in and learning about sustainable living practices. The program will take place in our food forest in the Peloponnesian peninsula, Greece.



This is an opportunity for students, trainees and young people, as well as for professors, teachers, trainers, youth workers, staff of education institutions and civil society organisations to undertake a learning experience in another country.

Every young person or youth worker taking part in this youth mobility project is entitled to go through the Youthpass process and receive a **Youthpass certificate** at the end.



Arrival day: 18th of June

Course days: 19-29th of June (11 days)

Departure day: 30 th of June

Where: At the Southern Lights farm, in Skala, 23051, Lakonia, Greece

Fee: 130€ per participant

As a **Sending Organisation**, you will be in charge of sending young people and youth workers to Greece (this includes: organising practical arrangements; preparing participants before departure; providing support to participants during all the phases of the project).

If you would like to take part as a participating/sending organisation, your organisation must be:

- established and registered in a EU country;
- working in at least one of this fields: sustainable development, agro-ecology, renewable energies, alternative education, arts of movement, training, youth, migration (including refugees and asylum seekers), socio-economic/ethnic/sexual minorities, disabilities and special needs.
